Kroger Returns to Duke Pharmacy Network

Did You Know...

Kroger and its network of pharmacies (including Harris Teeter) have been added back to many of the Express Scripts networks—including our Duke Pharmacy Benefit. This will expand patient access to a broader range of pharmacies for vaccinations and prescriptions. Kroger was previously removed from the Duke Pharmacy Benefit in January of 2023.

What Does this Mean for Providers & Patients?

This new agreement will enable members under the Duke Pharmacy Benefit to access prescriptions and vaccines at *Kroger* entities, as seen in the list below.

The Duke Pharmacy Benefit Offers the Following Benefit at Retail Pharmacies:

Medications will process at the lesser of their total cost or member copay up to a 34-day supply. Maintenance medications (such as those taken regularly to treat blood pressure, diabetes, and thyroid conditions) will have a penalty assessed on the 4th fill (up to 50% of the cost of the medication). To avoid this penalty, fill maintenance medications for >34 days' supply at a preferred pharmacy.

For Maintenance Medications (preferred pharmacies):

- Can fill up to a 90-day supply
- Includes:
 - » Express Scripts Mail Order
 - » Duke Pharmacies
