

Additional notes related to the CMS CMP grant applications for tents and plexiglass per QSO 20-39

**NOTE from LIFE SAFETY CODE:**

any modifications to the outdoor space of a facility to accommodate safe visitation must be pre-approved by the DHSR Construction Section

Contact Bob Strother ([bob.strother@dhhs.nc.gov](mailto:bob.strother@dhhs.nc.gov)), 919 218-8061, with a description of the planned outdoor visitation structure or area, including an aerial view, simple site sketch, photos or other means that clearly shows building exits will not be blocked, and that pedestrians and residents will be protected from traffic and weather conditions, and that emergency vehicle traffic will not be blocked. Provide copies of any local permits issued by building and fire authorities. We may ask a few additional questions about any electrical wiring, heating or cooling equipment to be used, or how the temporary structure is to provide weather resistance for visitation.

**Other notes:**

- Shipping costs can be included in the cmp application
- Curtains cannot be included
- Although the focus of plexiglass is for outdoor visitation, it can be included for indoor visitation
